## Mayor's Zero Waste Awards

These winners diverted at least 92% of their companies' waste from the landfill to various recycling and compost programs:

**A&M Carpet** - Recycled over one million pounds of carpet and padding last year alone.

**Grundfos Pumps** – Diverted nearly 450 tons of wood, green clippings, cardboard, aluminum and plastic bottles, shrink wrap, and glass from the landfill.

## Mauor's Business Regucling Awards

These winners diverted at least 75% of their companies' waste from the landfill to various recycling and compost programs:

**American Vintage Thrift** – Collected thousands of tons of clothing, shoes, books, electronics, toys and appliances to be reused or recycled.

**Body del Sol Medical Spa** – Recycled all product containers, used spa slippers made from recycled rubber, and reduced water and energy consumption.

**Cobblestone Village Apartments** – Partnered with Civilian Conservation Corp to collect an average of 200 pounds of appliances per week.

**De Young Properties** – Diverted 70 tons of concrete, wood, drywall, and cardboard from the landfill in a single month. Richard Heath & Associates – Purchased recycled materials whenever

possible and recycled all technology items, including cell phones and batteries. United Carpet One – Diverted over 120 tons of carpet and carpet padding last year alone.
